A fee is payable for the standardized questionnaires, the cognitive testing, the interpretation of the results and the report writing. Patients may be eligible for insurance reimbursement for some or all of the testing fee – though you will have to check with your insurance provider to ensure your coverage. If this assessment isn't right for you, then we encourage you to see one of the other experts in the community for assessment of ADHD.
